Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)

I am a PhD in Psychology for the National University of Distance Education (UNED) in Madrid (Spain, 2000), and Master in Cognitive Behavioural Therapy at the same University (U.N.E.D, 1995). Throughout almost 20 years I have been teaching different subjects of intervention and psychological evaluation such as Personality, Evaluation and Psychological Treatments. My research during this period has focused on the field of children's emotions and family socialization, mainly related to depression and aggression as well as the psychological adjustment of children and adolescents. Particularly, I have studied variables related to: parenting (i.e., hostility, affection and parental rejection), temperament (i.e., rhythmicity, temperamental difficulty, inhibition, effort of control), personality (i.e., empathy, prosociality, self-efficacy, Big Five), cognitive processes (i.e., cognitive biases, moral disengagement) and life events (i.e, sexual abuse, maltreatment and neglect). I have participated in the design (i.e., SENA, EAN) and Spanish adaptation of different tests (i.e., BFQ-N, CDI, Self-efficacy Scale) and I have conducted research stays in international centers such as the Research Unit on

Children's Psychosocial Maladjustment of the Faculté des Arts et des Sciences of the University of Montreal (Canada) with Professor Richard Tremblay; and in the Human Development and Family Studies Department of the University of Connecticut with Professor Ronal Rohner. In addition, I have been coordinating the Applied Psychology Service of the UNED from 2002 to 2019 in which I carry out clinical supervision and clinical care. Since October 2019, I am the Director of this Clinical Service. My scientific productivity includes 32 book-chapters, 10 books, 90 articles in peer-reviewed journals (67 indexed in JCR) and three commercialized tests. I have also directed 7 doctoral theses, and I have participated in 7 national research projects (two of them as Principal Investigator) and now I am working on one international project (ERASMUS+) as Principal Investigator of my Partner University. I have also been member of 4 research teams (2 consolidated and 1 of them as lead researcher). Among my most recent publications, I have published as co-editor with the Pfr. Rohner a special issue with 13 studies from more than 11 countries around the world in the Journal of Cross-cultural Research in 2014. I am a member of International Scientific Societies such as the European Psychological Assessment and the International Society of Interpersonal Acceptance-rejection, and I am co-editor of the Journal "Acción Psicológica" of the UNED publisher. In addition, since November 2018 I hold the position of Treasurer of the Spanish Society for the Advancement of the Spanish Psychological Evaluation (SEAEP). I am also a member of different scientific committees in JCR Journals and I have been part of organizing and scientific committees in different international congresses.
